- Ensure quality by verifying persons are competent based on appropriate education, training, or experience.
- Operate within the capabilities of our assets, ensuring they remain safe and efficient through our computerized maintenance management system (CMMS).
- Document and process observations made by advisory and inspection bodies. Provide action plans to close out relevant findings.

- Demonstrate a visible commitment to Health and Safety in everything we do.

- Monitor and maintain Process Safety integrity to prevent major accidents or respond through our robust emergency response teams.
- Improve, measure & monitor individual competency through position-based training and mentoring.
- Report all incidents, investigate vigorously to prevent re-occurrence, and share lessons.
- Develop, measure, and monitor KPIs for performance.
- Promote & reinforce employee feedback, celebrate success, and recognize individual and collective performance.
- Communicate with internal and external sources, capture best practices, and promote "people, process, plant" improvement through self-verification and monitoring.
- Use contractor HSE performance to inform decision-making in the procurement of services.
